



Additional Wine Selections

2016 Lost Angel Moscato, Sonoma 6 / 12 / 46

Bursting with floral aromas of jasmine and rose accompanied by rich flavors of fresh orange peel and lychee.

2002 Billecart-Salmon Champagne, Brut, France \$205 (bottle only)

A lovely color of sparkling yellow gold veiled in luminous golden reflections. Fine malted notes associated with orchard fruits such as white peach and nectarine, refined by the purity of complex mandarin zest aromas.

2013 Matanzas Creek Merlot, Sonoma Valley 6 / 12 / 46

Red-blue fruit with notes of sage, peppercorn and licorice.
Firm tannins support a long finish

2014 Belle Glos "Clark and Telephone" Pinot Noir, 8.5 / 17 / 66 **Santa Maria Valley**

Aromas of blackberry bramble, nutmeg, with a hint of caramel. The wine is fresh and exuberant in the mouth with sumptuous strawberry jam, ripe black cherry, cranberry and warm gingerbread.

2014 Failla Pinot Noir, Sonoma Coast 11 / 21 / 85

Warm tones of baking spice, wild sage, balsam & classic cherry coulis.
Fine tannins & bright, bold acidity give structure to the juicy berry palate.

2014 Orin Swift, Machete, Northern California 10 / 20 / 75

Petite Sirah, Syrah, and Grenache. Aromas of ripe blueberries and candied plum mingle with toasted oak and charred vanilla.

2014 Falcone Family Vineyards, Annate, Paso Robles 18 / 35 / 140

Aromas of blackberry and blueberry dominate, with savory roasted notes and a hint of anise. Several vintages comprise this blend of Cabernet, Syrah and Petite Sirah.

2013 Freemark Abbey, Knight's Valley Cabernet Sonoma 9 / 18 / 68

Forward aromas of brambly fruit, damp forest floor & dark chocolate. Deep cherry & blackberry, with rich viscosity & a lingering, balanced fruit finish

2014 Regusci Cabernet, Stag's Leap, Napa 10 / 20 / 80

Sweet spice, briar fruit and toast on the nose, unfolding into currant, anise, & a whiff of pencil lead followed by dark berry fruit. Lively, brisk mouth feel.

2009 Charles Woodson 24, Cabernet, Napa 12 / 24 / 95

Black licorice and wild berry aromas. Rich, dense, and plush on the palate with a lingering, vibrant finish

2011 Pedroncelli Port, Dry Creek Valley Estate 10 (glass)

Ripe berries, rich caramel and toffee aromas with warm spice, raspberry and cream soda highlights
