Tooth & Nail Wines ~ Paso Robles

From Rob Murray Vineyards & the Tolliver Ranch on Paso's eastern side.
Lush, concentrated flavors in a trio of original and vivid blends.

2014 The Fiend 6 / 12 / 46

86% Malbec, 8% Cabernet, 4% Petite Sirah, 2% Syrah
Inky & opulent with aromas of herbs, licorice, Asian spices & dark chocolate

2014 The Possessor 6 / 12 / 46

88% Cabernet Sauvignon, 7% Malbec, 5% Petite Sirah
Spunky, intense & smooth with licorice, black fruit & oak on the palate.

2014 The Stand 6 / 12 / 46

80% Petite Sirah, 10% Syrah, 10% Malbec
Deep & supple tannins, dark fruit with whisper of scorched earth

Pinot Noir Flight 21.5

2014 Nielson By Byron, Santa Barbara County 5.5 / 11 / 42

From the oldest commercial vineyard in Santa Barbara County.
A light & lively, mineral character, touched by raspberry, rose petal & smoke.

2014 J. Christopher, Willamette Valley 7.5 / 15 / 58

Forward, fruity and flavorful, this is a quite pretty compendium of raspberry
and cherry fruit, accented with a touch of orange peel.

2012 Attune, Sonoma Carneros 8.50 / 17 / 64

A Pinot for Cab drinkers! Big & bold with dark, roasted spice,
yet still elegant with sweet notes of black cherry, plum & tobacco on the finish

Zinfandel Flight 20.5

2013 The Immortal Zin, Lodi 6 / 12 / 46

From 100 yr old 'immortal' vines tended over 6 generations by the Peirano family.
Velvety cherry, strawberry, & cocoa with light toast & smooth tannins.

2014 Opolo Mountain Zin, Paso Robles 6 / 12 / 46

Jammy aromas of raspberry and plum balanced by floral
lavender and violet with a long, satisfying finish

2013 Ed Meades, Perli Vineyards, Mendocino Ridge 8.5 / 17 / 66

Aromas of fresh blackberries, black currants, cedar, and spicy forest hardwoods.
On the palate, blackberry liqueur and plum flavors are complimented by a
slightly smoky and meaty character.

2012 Estate Coccineous, Las Positas Vineyards, Livermore 6 / 12 / 46

A luxurious, full-bodied blend of Tempranillo, Petite Sirah, Syrah, & Malbec.
Flavors of blackberry, mocha, spice, & lingering cherry

2015 Trifethen, Dragon Tooth, Oak Knoll, Napa 8 / 16 / 58

This alluring blend of Malbec, Petite Verdot and Cabernet features rich aromas of blackberry and cracked pepper. On the palate, the flavors include more dark berries and a touch of freshly baked pastry.

2015 Abstract, Napa, Sonoma and Mendocino 8.50 / 17 / 60

A blend of Grenache, Petite Sirah, and Syrah. Aromatic notes of cherries, ripe black plums and raspberries with intricate hints of coffee, mocha and caramel in the background. The wine finishes with a hint of wild cherry and a lingering sweet oak presence.

Alternative Red Flight 19.5

2015 Counoise, Broc Cellars, Eagle Point Ranch, Mendocino 6 / 12 / 46

Aromas of cherry, strawberry, spice and a hint of mineral. On the palate, black cherry and strawberry flavors are followed by a peppery finish.

2014 Malbec, Cuda Ridge Wines, Livermore 7.5 / 15 / 55

Deep plum color. Ample tannins that still leave room for soft, ripe plum flavors and a spicy long lasting finish. A staff favorite!

2014 Petite Petit, Michael David Winery, Lodi 6 / 12 / 46

Dark & inky, highlighted by blueberry, blackberry, graphite & a hint of licorice.
An exquisite blend of Petite Sirah & Petit Verdot.

Cabernet Sauvignon Flight 20

2013 Mazzocco, Dry Creek, Sonoma 6 / 12 / 46

Black currant, cherry and chocolate on the nose.
Balanced on the palate with cassis, berry, leather & licorice

2011 Mia Nipote, Livermore 7 / 14 / 45

Silky, integrated tannins balanced by blackberry, cassis, & mocha

2012 Nottingham Cellars, Livermore 8 / 16 / 58

Local vineyards, Smith Ranch and Casa de Vinas grapes create an absolute force of flavors. The opulent fresh fruit of blackberries marry with cocoa and chocolaty tones revealing a vibrant acidity.
